MINUTES OF THE FINANCE AND GENERAL PURPOSES COMMITTEE HELD AT THE VILLAGE HALL, NORLEY ROAD CUDDINGTON ON MONDAY 5TH SEPTEMBER 2016, COMMENCING AT 1PM.

1. **Apologies:** None.
2. **Declarations of Interest.** There were no disclosures of any (a) Disclosable Pecuniary Interests and, (b) Other Disclosable Interests as required under Chapter 7 of the Localism Act 2011 and Cuddington Parish Council's Code of Conduct.
3. Budget 2017-2018. The meeting first studied the current monthly expenditure monitor, the clerk advised the meeting that due to the recent vandalism at Boundary Lane Green play area the Council's budget for Village Maintenance has already been exceeded by £458.00.
It was **RESOLVED** to recommend to full Council that they:
 - Request that St John's church seeks volunteers from amongst their congregation to carry out the task of putting the lights on the Christmas tree that is provided each year by the Parish Council.
 - That the annual budget for Village Maintenance increases in 2017/2018.
 - That a sinking fund is created to cover any future maintenance costs of the Weaverham Road car park.

It was noted that, during the precept calculations meeting which will be scheduled in November the committee shall identify items for reserve funds and consider increasing the S137 budget.
