Action Notes for the meeting of the Implementation Group held on Monday 10th July 2017 at the Village Hall commencing 7.00pm

The Chairman welcomed those present and thanked everyone for their work over the last month.

ACTION NOTES MEETING 12TH JUNE 2017: had been circulated and were approved as a correct record

WORKING GROUP DOCUMENTS: The latest had been circulated before the meeting

WORKING GROUP REPORTS

ENVIRONMENT: Sarah reported that in August there would be an organised litter pick Nixon Road/ Grange Lane. There would also be annual organised litter picks. The Library would continue as the hub for borrowing equipment. In fact they are very willing to extend this role to other aspects of community work. The Group was to engage with the Spar Store to try and encourage them to tidy up more. Sarah reported that planting around the village was to take place Saturday and Sunday 9th & 10th and 16th & 17th September. Publicity being given for volunteers to come forward. Meeting with CWAC on energy savings being arranged. Allotments: Group ready to enter into discussions with Taylor Wimpey/ Parish Council on governance/ self-management issues. Still some difficulty in getting Taylor Wimpey to engage.

FACILITIES & COMMUNITY: David reported that website activity now settling into a satisfactory pattern. Work continued on the current Neighbourhood Plan consultation. Calendar has been slimmed down giving more profile to forthcoming events. Work continues on connectivity and a good neighbour voluntary scheme. Other actions deemed complete.

TRAFFIC & TRANSPORT: Sandiway Shops parking restrictions currently out for public consultation. Group is meeting Highways shortly to monitor progress on agreed improvements. Group are talking to Village Hall and Tennis Club to try and address parking problems at Village Hall at peak times. Highways have agreed to make good and re-seed grass verges on Mere Lane. Further meeting due in August re adding destinations to bus service. Improvements to rail service with effect from May 2018 published and currently out for public consultation.

VILLAGE PLAN SIGNING OFF DOCUMENT: It was agreed that the document for each of the working groups would be reviewed at the next Implementation Group meeting and decisions will then be made on arrangements including timings.
