NEW ZEBRA CROSSING ON NORLEY ROAD

Cuddington Parish Council are delighted that Cheshire West have finally provided a much-needed additional crossing point on Norley Road from section 106 money.

This has been on the wish list for a number of Cuddington and Sandiway residents for some years.

The project was initially started back in 2013 with Cllr Kerrigan and the late Cllr Ken Nixon liaising with Cheshire West and Chester Council, Julie confirmed "Ken would of been delighted that the project is finally coming to fruition, both Councillors worked tirelessly on this project for a number of years. It is also an ideal opportunity to create a pathway into the playing fields and an additional disabled bay in the car park.

- Change of use of land to include equestrian use and erection of timber stables and all weather arena at 57 Warrington Road. The council decided it was not able to support this application as it is on Green Belt land and would constitute a change of use and also could have a negative impact on residential properties close to the land.
- The council is going to purchase a new bench to commemorate the Coronation of King Charles. The bench will replace one of our existing benches which is in poor condition.
- The Resilience Plan that the council has been working on has now been approved. The new Committee will have powers to take immediate action in an emergency. They will be equipped with yellow hi-viz jackets with Cuddington Parish Council on, torches, silver blankets and badges with photo ID.

OUR YOUTH CLUB GOES FROM STRENGTH TO STRENGTH

The Cuddington & Sandiway Youth Club entered a team into the Rotary Swimathon. Six young lads swam a total of 125 lengths and so far have raised over £600 for the Youth Club, St Luke's and the Multiple Sclerosis Society.

The Youth Club is now open every Friday thanks to funding by the Police Commissioner of Cheshire and has steadily grown in attendance to over 40 young people. We have a fantastic group of helpers but with the number of young people attending we still would benefit from additional volunteers. 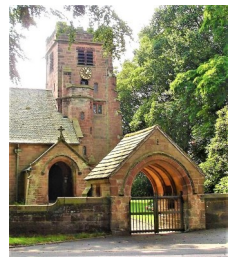
