CHANGES AT REDWALLS

A representative from Kingsley Health Care attended the council meeting on July 20th to discuss building work to Redwalls Nursing Home on Weaverham Road.

The most significant work will be the demolition and rebuilding of part of an existing extension which no longer meets current legislation eg each residents' room to have en suite facilities.

There will also be another 8 rooms built, bringing the total number of residents to 50 and a new exit will be created on Weaverham Road nearer to the junction with Norley Road. This has been accepted by Highways.

Redwalls, built in 1906-7 and once known as Homestead is a Grade 2 listed building and is in the Sandiway Conservation Area. It has been stated that there would be no change to the north and west aspects of the property while the south has already been compromised.

The plan will include the removal of 8 trees and some shrubs and hedgerows which is against the Neighbourhood Plan policy 3, Protecting Trees, Hedgerows and Vegetation

Residents attended the meeting to express their concerns. These included extra traffic and parking on the road as only 2 extra spaces are planned on site, and concerns the new exit will make crossing the road near the junction with Norley Road more hazardous. They also highlighted possible negative impacts on their neighbouring properties .

Recently the parish council has received several complaints about the footpath between Norley Road and Weaverham Road. In one instance it involved problems with a mobility scooter.

Many of us will have had to step off the path to pass people coming the other way here and it is a worry for parents as the path accesses a primary school and a playground.

To try and help the situation the parish council will be asking residents on that stretch of road to ensure that their hedges are not extending past their boundary lines.

The 2253 Chester to Manchester (normally due Cuddington 2315) will be a bus calling at
Cuddington at 2345. It will call at Knutsford and beyond only if required to set down passengers.
The 2313 from Manchester to Chester (normally due Cuddington 0020) will be a bus calling at
all stations (Cuddington 0120).
