A YOUNG MAN ON A MISSION

Many people were shocked when Christian Eriksen collapsed during a recent Euro 2020 match. His life was saved by the prompt attention of medics and the use of a defibrillator. Oscar Jones was watching the game with his dad and wanted to know what was happening. It occurred to him that something similar could happen during one of his team's matches. Oscar plays for Cuddington and Sandiway under 7s and his dad Ben is one of their coaches. Ben explains that all FA coaches are trained in CPR and the use of defibrillators but there is no guarantee that one will be available when they play their matches. Oscar wanted to do something about this so he has set out to run a marathon to raise money for a portable one for his team. He will run a mile a day for 26 days, thus covering the distance of a full marathon. He has already raised in excess of £6,400 which will not only provide one for his team but will buy 5 to be used in the local community.

There are 2 defibrillators in the village, one is situated by the entrance to the village hall and the other is in the telephone box in Poplar Close which the parish council recently acquired from BT. However many matches are played on Weaverham Road which was created to allow more of our young people, like Oscar, where there may not be a defibrillator available. One day Oscar's heroic efforts may save a life.



Also the teams travel for away games where there may not be a defibrillator available. One day save a life.

PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

The next meeting of the parish council will take place on July 19th in the main room of the village hall commencing at 7.15 pm

The parish council has received an invitation which is extended to all residents of the village.

A commemorative service to celebrate the Centenary of the War Memorial which stands outside St Mary's Parish Church in Weaverham will be held on July 24th at 11am.

When this memorial was erected in 1921 Sandiway was part of Weaverham ecclesiastical parish. Our parish church, St John the Evangelist, was not built until 1902-3 and was licensed in 1903 as a chapel of ease to St Mary's in Weaverham. It was not until 1935 that Sandiway became a parish in its own right therefore there are a number of Sandiway residents named on this Memorial.

Weaverham Parish Council have therefore extended this kind invitation to all our residents. The service will be held next to the Memorial and there will be light refreshments in the Church Hall after the service.

- In 2022, Her Majesty The Queen will become the first British Monarch to celebrate a Platinum Jubilee, seventy years of service, having acceded to the throne on 6th February 1952 when Her Majesty was 25 years old. The Parish Council are facilitating a working party to consider a village event for the Queen's Platinum celebration in June 2022.
- Our CWAC Ward Councillors' funding application for £1000 for litter picking equipment for the village has been approved. The parish council will match fund this and purchase their own litter picking equipment for use in the village.

The Boundary Commission for England has published its initial proposal for new Parliamentary Constituencies. In this proposal the constituency of Eddisbury would become South Cheshire and its boundaries would change. This change would put Cuddington and Sandiway into a new constituency called Northwich. The public is invited to view the proposal and submit their comments. You can do this, and view a map of the changes by going to;

Sundays 4, 11, 18 and 25 July. All trains are replaced by buses between Chester and Stockport. The timetable for 4 July is on the Northern web site (see above) and it is expected that it will also apply to the other Sundays in July. Connections between Stockport and Manchester are not advertised but there are about 9 trains an hour. Bus departures from Cuddington, Norley Road shops, will be at:

To Stockport: 0954, 1146, 1349, 1554, 1759, 1955, 2149 (through to Manchester).

To Chester: 1059 and every 2 hours until 2059, 2305.

On 18 July there are no buses advertised to Chester until the 1659

Monday 19th to Thursday 22nd July: Buses replace the 2252 Chester to Manchester (calling at Cuddington at 2342), and 2341 Manchester to Chester (setting down only at Cuddington at 0136).

An additional bus departs Knutsford at 0025 (Tuesday to Friday mornings) to Chester, calling at Cuddington at 0108.
