- A piece of land owned by the council is being sold at auction. Known as Fleamoss Pit, it is situated behind Oakmere Wealth Management on Warrington road and for many years has simply been wasteland. Previous attempts have been made to sell it without success.
- A Ukrainian family has arrived in Cuddington seeking refuge from the terrifying conditions in their home country. Many people will have seen lamp posts on the A49 decorated in Ukrainian colours to welcome them.
- Double yellow lines are to be introduced on Ash Road in order to ease the parking problems there. However the road is due to be resurfaced later this year so the lines will not be done until after this has happened.
- The problem of gullies around the village was brought up. There are places where they regularly flood after heavy rain and although they are supposed to be cleared annually this is obviously not enough in some cases. Councillor Edwards has offered to take this matter up.
- Weeds were another problem mentioned. They are prevalent in many places and make the village look untidy.
- A safety check at Boundary Lane Green Play Area has revealed several problems which need urgent attention at a cost of £1400. Steps and handrails are in poor condition and if not replaced the playground will have to be closed.
- Another area which needs urgent attention for safety reasons is the tennis wall on the playing field where the concrete base is degrading.
- It has been noted that there are many instances of people exercising their dogs on the playing field. Dogs are not allowed on the field. This is for the protection of our children as dog faeces can carry diseases and clearing up after your dog is not enough. Better signage will be put up to inform people. Dogs can be taken along the footpath to Greenfield Way.
