RETRACTION.

"In the June edition of the Round Tower it was stated in the Parish Council News that a stone wall had been removed during the current renovation work on Croft House, Weaverham Road.

This was INCORRECT and the Parish Council unreservedly apologizes for any distress caused by this report."

The report has now been retracted from June's edition of the Round Tower which is displayed on the community website <u>www.cuddngtonandsandiwayonline.org</u>

The parish council is now up to full strength as Phil Holman has been welcomed to the council as a member for Delamere Park ward.

Members of the public came along to request the council's support in getting the 40 mile speed limit on the A556 extended beyond 637 and nearby properties. They explained that noise and vibration from HGVs is very intrusive, even waking people up at night. The noise is made worse by the many potholes on the road. It was also noted that existing traffic signs are obscured by trees. Cllr Gillian Edwards has requested a review of the speed limit.

Pot holes were the main focus of attention at the meeting as they are now becoming dangerous in many places, causing motorists to drive erratically to avoid them. They are particularly hazardous for cyclists. People are puzzled by the fact that maintenance workers come along and mend a pot hole and then depart, leaving one that is just as bad a few yards down the road. It was suggested that if people report problem potholes it may get them further up the list.

'Report It' was also recommended for reporting fly tipping - but when doing so please include a photo.

Monday 3 July: the 2252 Chester to Manchester (23.14 from Cuddington) does not appear in the timetable for that day. This could be an error - check on the day if you want to use it.

Tuesday 4 to Thursday 6 July: The 2252 Chester to Manchester (normally due Cuddington 2314) will be a bus calling at Cuddington at 2342.

The 2210 from Manchester will stop at Greenbank at 2303 but will then run nonstop to Chester. A replacement bus will leave Altrincham at 2245 and call at all stations (Greenbank 2349, Cuddington 2357).

The 2313 from Manchester (normally due Cuddington 0020) will be a bus Calling at Cuddington at 0108. A complete timetable is on the Northern web site.
