MINIATURE RAILWAY SOCIETY CELEBRATES 50 YEARS WITH A CHARITY GALA

Saturday 6 July: 11:30am, official opening by Kim Smith of Radio Northwich with parade of engines; public running from 12:00 noon to 4:00pm; drive a locomotive at various times during the day.

Sunday 7 July: public running from 12:00 noon to 4:00pm; visiting steam roller running all day.

All proceeds go to Simply The Breast, which raises money for the Mid Cheshire Hospitals Charity.

Mid Cheshire Society of Model Engineers was founded in 1974, when an article appeared in the local newspaper penned by a local builder appealing for people interested in model engineering to contact him with a view to forming a local society. It purchased its site at Sandiway Wood in 2012, with the first trains running there a year later

Monday 15 to Thursday 18 July: The 2252 Chester to Manchester (normally due Cuddington 2314) will be a bus calling at Cuddington at 2342.

The 2210 from Manchester will stop at Greenbank at 2303 but will then run non stop to Chester. A connecting replacement bus will leave Altrincham at 2250 and call at all stations (Greenbank 2354, Cuddington 0002).

The 2313 from Manchester (normally due Cuddington 0020) will be a bus calling at Cuddington at 0108.

Sundays 7 to 28 July inclusive: All trains will be replaced by buses calling outside Norley Road shops. To Chester, they will depart at 1208 and every 2 hours until 2208. To Stockport (for trains to Manchester) they will depart at 0855 and every 2 hours until 2055.
