Following on from the village Gala Day, Cuddington parish council has organised a picnic in the park on Saturday evening from 6.30pm, June 4, and is urging everyone to bring their own crisps, treats and sandwiches down to the park to celebrate the Queen's 70 year reign.

Julie, parish clerk, said: "We have organised this so everyone can get involved. Everyone is getting into the spirit of the Jubilee, and we thought it would be a good idea to follow on from the village Gala Day, where grown-ups and families come back to their "childhood homes" to attend the Gala Day, so what better day to celebrate together with your family and have a catch up with old school friends.

"We just hope the weather stays nice."

The Jubilee beacon will be lit at 7pm, local legend "Taxi Mike" will provide a disco, playing a wide range of music including any requests and Lostock Ukulele band will also be playing.

Refreshments may be bought from the beer tent, or people may also bring their own along, with their picnics.

We hope it will be a fantastic day and a free evening of family celebrations for all residents of Cuddington, Sandiway and Delamere Park.

A Service of Thanksgiving for the Queen's reign will be held at St John's church on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> June at 6.30pm, weather permitting this will be an outdoor service in the grounds of St John's on Norley Road.

Further information will be posted on your local notice boards at Mere Lane and at the Playing fields.

The parish Council is liaising with the transport department at Cheshire West to see if they would be able to assist with a Community Transport provider. This is to help residents of the village with no transport to get to their appointments at Danebridge Medical Centre or Kingsmead surgery. This is considered to be necessary due to the poor transport provision in the village.

A vote of thanks was given to Michael Jones for planting the Cherry blossom tree at Boundary Lane Green play area following the vandalism last year. The council was overwhelmed by the generosity of residents who offered to help replace the tree.

#### **New Trees**

Last spring the Playing Fields Association asked local specialist Ascent Arboriculture Ltd to carry out a safety inspection of trees at the Field. In their report Ascent recommended the removal of three trees alongside the Scout Hut as two were dead and the other was in poor condition. Ascent were asked to proceed with the recommended work and they offered to plant, free of charge, three new trees in place of those they would remove. The new trees, Cherry, Whitebeam and Rowan, have now been planted and will contribute to the Field landscape for many years to come.
