A556 PLANNING PERMISSION APPLICATIONS UPDATE

Just before Christmas, both Redrow and Barratt/David Jones Homes submitted revisions to their applications to build on fields next to the A556. The Residents' Action Group achieved a small extension to the very short objection deadlines, plus an assurance that previously submitted objections would remain valid. These planning applications are still being opposed by residents, the Parish Council and Councillor Gillian Edwards, and have NOT been approved!

The main revisions were:

25/02017/FUL (field opposite Blue Cap)

- Site entrance moved from opposite the Blue Cap to the corner adjacent to Pool Lane with a 3-arm junction and Keep Clear markings for Blue Cap and Pool Lane
- Inclusion of allotments on the Cockpit Lane side
- Change from 112 to 115 dwellings with fewer 1 & 2-bed dwellings and more 3-bed
- Moving the play space next to Pool Lane
- More prominent houses in visible places including a 'statement' affordable housing block near the corner of Cockpit Lane and Chester Road
- Payment into a central healthcare fund of £175k to acknowledge Public Health's assessment that there is *"under provision for the village currently and that no more residents can be absorbed into local GP services"*
- 25/02111/FUL (fields either side of Dalefords Lane)
- Change to proposed house types
- Inclusion of allotments on the Cockpit Lane side of the field between Dalefords Lane & Cockpit Lane
- Unsupported promises that wildlife, the Petty Pool Site of Special Scientific Interest and TPO trees would not be affected and there will eventually be a biodiversity net gain. Natural England have expressed concerns
- Payment into a central healthcare fund of £180k to acknowledge Public Health's assessment that there is *"under provision for the village currently and that no more residents can be absorbed into local GP services"*

We continue to oppose these applications due to poor location, local road safety, protection of agricultural land and biodiversity for future generations, additional strain on local resources and the protection of the CWAC Local Plan and the Sandiway & Cuddington Neighbourhood Plan.

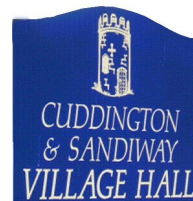

- Access census, marriage, birth, death, military, immigration and other records on Ancestry.com and Findmypast, free of charge
- Search through old newspaper articles from the UK and Ireland for free on the [British Newspaper Archive](http://BritishNewspaperArchive.com)
- Browse local maps, photographs, and records, and read books on local history.

You can also join our Ancestry club on Fridays from 3.30pm to 5pm. Come along to chat with fellow family history-enthusiasts for encouragement and support.

It is free to join the library and you don't need any ID to join. Whilst in the library, you can borrow books, e-books, audio books and e-magazines for free, plus enjoy free Wi-Fi and refreshments.
