What is wrong with people? On Friday 29th March at around 6pm, the men's toilets at Norley Road playing fields were vandalized yet again. The soap dispenser and the hand dryer were ripped off the wall.

Together, the playing fields management group and the parish council have said this kind of malicious damage is very disappointing, and we urge anybody with information to contact via email: trustees@cuddingtonandsandivillagehall.org.uk

In many of our surrounding villages there are no public toilets available due to the high costs of vandalism, and this is not something that the management group and the parish council want on their agenda, as they feel it will be detrimental to many visitors of the park. The matter is now in the hands of Cheshire Police.

Floral displays at both Norley Road and Mere Lane shops have been planted out by a small group who got together last year via face book, they told Cllr Chrimes that, in the same way bees pollinate, they wanted to pollinate the community.
