YOUTH CLUB MOSAIC PROJECT COMPLETE

An art project which has involved many village residents has created 3 panels which now adorn the station, showcasing highlights of our village. Financial support came from a Cheshire West Creative Arts/UKSPF grant with contributions from the Rotary Club of Northwich Centenary Fund, Cuddington Parish Council, Friends of Cuddington Station and Mid Cheshire Community Rail Partnership.

Artistic support came from Beth Barlow and Jan Johnson with the help of many volunteers from around the village. As well as members of the Youth Club, both of our Primary schools were involved, with pupils working alongside residents from our Residential Homes. The project took many months and is now complete and on display at the station.

There will be an Opening Ceremony on May 4th at 10.30am at the station followed by soft drinks and refreshments at the Youth Club on the playing field.

Sunday 18 May: New timetable commences. The only *earlier* departures from Cuddington will be at 1017, 1117 and 2218 to Manchester, Mondays to Saturdays

Monday 6 to Thursday 9 May: The 2252 Chester to Manchester (normally due Cuddington 2314) will be a bus calling at Cuddington at 2342. The 2210 from Manchester will stop at Greenbank at 2303 but will then run non stop to Chester. A connecting replacement bus will leave Altrincham at 2250 and call at all stations (Greenbank 2354, Cuddington 0002). The 2313 from Manchester (normally due Cuddington 0020) will be a bus Calling at Cuddington at 0108.

Wednesday 14 May: Music Train. Lynchpins and Dave Vaughan on the 1856 from Chester, Cuddington 1918, then at the Golden Pheasant, Plumley. Return on 2157 from Plumley, arriving Cuddington 2217.
