Monday 4 to Thursday 7 November: The 2313 Manchester Piccadilly to Chester service will depart at 2311. Other times are unchanged

Monday 18 to Thursday 21 November: The 2252 Chester to Manchester (normally due at Cuddington 2314) will be a bus calling at Cuddington at 2342. The 2210 from Manchester will stop at Greenbank at 2303 but will then run non stop to Chester. A connecting replacement bus will leave Altrincham at 2250 and call at all stations (Greenbank 2354, Cuddington 0002). The 2313 from Manchester (normally due Cuddington 0020) will be a bus Calling at Cuddington at 0108
