- A plan has been submitted for 7 dwellings at Cheshire Hunt Kennels on Kennel Lane. These are for buildings that are no longer used by the Kennels because of the changes in modern animal welfare. Converting them into dwellings will prevent them from falling into disrepair. The plan states that the character of these buildings will be retained. The Parish Council noted that the plan included 2 and 3 bedroomed properties which are needed in the village according to the Neighbourhood plan and it was therefore approved.
- It was noted that when the last renovation took place at the Shell garage we were promised 2 Electric Charger points. We still only have one so this will be followed up.
- Councillors were pleased to hear that safety measures have been made to the steps leading from St John's Way to the Blue Cap Car Park where previously there was a gap that a small child could slip through, resulting in a dangerous fall.
