We have only two months to **raise final concerns** to influence the CWAC Planning Department's final decision.

Saturday 4 October. Reduced service Chester - Altrincham only, with currently no information on availability of rail tickets on buses or trams beyond Altrincham.

Cuddington departures to Chester: 0816 and approximately 16 minutes past even hours until 0026

To Altrincham: 0618, 0818, 1027, 1228, 1420, 1628, 1828, 2028, 2228.

Sunday 5 October Replacement buses from outside Norley Road shops.

To Chester: 1105 and 2-hourly until 2305. To Manchester: 0840 and 2-hourly until 2040

Monday 20 to Thursday 23 October: The 2252 Chester to Manchester (normally due Cuddington 2314) will be a bus calling at Cuddington at 2342.

The 2210 from Manchester will stop at Greenbank at 2303 but will then run non stop to Chester. A connecting replacement bus will leave Altrincham at 2250 and call at all stations (Greenbank 2354, Cuddington 0002). The 2313 from Manchester (normally due Cuddington 0020) will be a bus Calling at Cuddington at 0108.
