MID CHESHIRE LINE BATON RELAY

Rail 200 - the celebration of 200 years of rail travel, has a series of events in the Autumn.

From 22nd - 27th September there will be a baton relay when volunteers will be walking from station to station closely following the route of the Mid Cheshire Line. The knitted baton, created by Northwich Toppers, will be passed from team to team along the route. The relay starts at Manchester Piccadilly on Monday 22nd September and ends at Chester on Saturday 27th September



The relay reaches our area on Friday 26 September leaving Greenbank at 11.35, calling in at Cuddington and departing from Cuddington at 13.05 heading for Delamere where the baton will rest overnight before starting the final stages at 8.30 am

There will also be heritage panels on display at each station, telling the story of our railway.



11:35 am Greenbank to Cuddington (3.0 miles/4.8 km)

1:05 pm Cuddington to Delamere (5.0 miles/8.0 km)

The enthusiast might like to join the next day, Saturday 27th, leaving Delamere at 8.30 am heading for Mouldsworth. Final stage leaves Mouldsworth at 10.30 arriving in Chester 10.5m/16.8 km later
